## This funding will be used to

- Improve teacher and staff competences through ongoing professional development to improve student outcomes in Literacy and Numeracy.
- Ensure the delivery of an intensive and explicit focus on Literacy/Numeracy/Writing, to guarantee 100% of year 3 and 5 students achieve at or above National Minimum Standards in NAPLAN Literacy and Numeracy in 2016.
- Invest in on-line eLearning and assistive technologies to ensure all students are engaged and assisted to achieve at or above National Minimum Standards.
- Support families with children in the Pre-Prep years with the facilitation of focused Early Childhood programs to ensure optimal transition of students into Prep in 2016 and beyond.

## Our strategy will be to

- Build teacher capability through professional development, explicit instruction and engagement in reflective professional conversations to ensure targeted student outcomes.
- Build teaching staff knowledge and capabilities to use technology to differentiate and improve learning.
- Utilise on-line lessons to develop literacy skills through structured reading and writing programs.
- Work collaboratively with Early Years community organisations' to ensure Great Start, Great Futures, initiatives are met.

## Our school will improve student outcomes by

Employing high-quality staff to deliver a 1:1 individualised school wide Reading Intervention Program in Semester 1.	\$2400
Participating in SAS (Students Achieving Success) intensive Reading and Writing Program for year 4 students in Semester 2.	\$600
Purchasing on-line eLearning annual subscriptions/apps and implementing the use of assistive technologies in Literacy and Numeracy to allow individual practice and progression.	\$500
Engaging in Professional Development and participating in a cluster schools approach to implementing the North Coast Region Mathematics Project and the 7 Steps to Writing Program.	\$1500

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Engaging in Professional Development to adopt a whole school approach to teaching phonics and spelling using the Jolly Phonics and THRASS programs.	School funded
Providing a teacher-aide in term 4 to assist with an individualised literacy and numeracy based program preparing Pre-Prep students transitioning to Prep in 2016.	School funded

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
